All Juniors will be taking the SAT from 8:30 to 12:30 on Wednesday, 3/1. They should arrive at 8:00 AM. Students can pick up a to-go breakfast and snack in the cafeteria. Students should then report to the upstairs E building and be in rooms by 8:23 AM

Students will find their room posting hanging up in the library windows Wednesday morning.

- The SAT is a big help in finding out which subjects need more practice and for improving the skills they already have.
- It can show which Advanced Placement Program (AP) courses students may be successful in.
