Blue - the traditional color for baby boys  
Pink - the traditional color for baby girls  
White - transitioning, neutral or no gender, or intersex

The transgender pride flag was designed by trans activist and US Navy veteran, Monica Helms, in 1999. Helms debuted the flag at a Pride parade in Phoenix, Arizona in 2000 and it has served as a symbol of the trans and gender non-conforming community ever since.


Here are some pictures of our team and our robot during the Ventura Regional March 9th-12th and also a link to the Channel 13 story about this amazing team and their trip to the world championships!
