Building Trades Summer Internships

This summer, Sac City is working in conjunction with the North State Building Industry Association (North State BIA) & Lennar Home Builders to offer students an unprecedented opportunity. Why should our kids work a simple summer job when they could get a jump start on a career and get ahead on some academic credits. Through the Sac City Summer Construction Internship students will work with the largest home builder in California and their subcontractors learning a wide array of skilled trades.

This is an incredible opportunity for our junior students as they prepare for their senior year. The program runs from June 19th through July 17th and students will work 40 hours a week for \$15.50 an hour. There will also be a school component where students will work with a teacher exploring and reflecting upon what they are learning and will earn 10 elective credits. While this will be hard work, there are many rewards for our students and a chance to see firsthand what a career in the skilled trades is really like.
