

Bodily Fluid Protocol

The following precautions/procedures should be followed to areas affected by bodily fluids.

- You must wear a mask and gloves. THIS IS MANDATORY!! NO EXCEPTIONS
- Apply absorbent material (D-Vour) to infected floors, carpet and furniture. Allow absorbent to set (5-10 minutes), then remove material and place in a plastic bag for removal.
- Sweep floor and vacuum carpet to remove excess absorbent material.
- Spray sinks, countertops, student desks, chairs and doorknobs and any other infected areas with a disinfectant solution. Solution should stay on surfaces WET for a minimum of 10 minutes. If disinfectant dries out before the 10 minutes, rewet surfaces.
- After 10 minutes, remove excess solution from surface.
- All items that came in contact with the bodily fluids (brooms, dustpans etc.) must be washed in the disinfectant solution.
- Dispose of mask and gloves into a plastic lined trash container.
- WASH HANDS FOR A MINIMUM OF 30 SECONDS.
