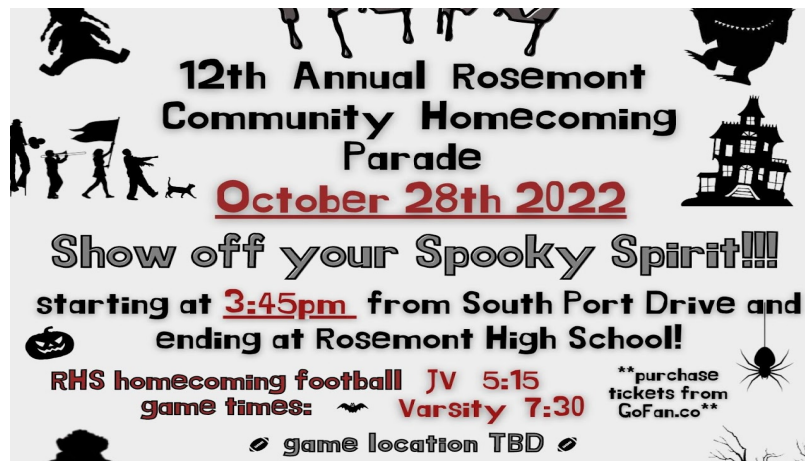

AP Scholar Awards

The AP Scholar Awards recognize high school students who have demonstrated exemplary college-level achievement on AP Exams, and there are three levels of awards: AP Scholar, AP Scholar with Honor, and AP Scholar with Distinction.

- To earn AP Scholar, students must receive an average score of 3 or higher on three or more AP Exams.
- To earn AP Scholar with Honor, students must receive an average score of 3.25 on all exams taken AND a 3 or higher on four or more AP Exams.
- To earn AP Scholar with Distinction, students must receive an average of 3.5 or higher on all exams taken AND a 3 or higher on five AP Exams.

In 2021-2022, 25 Rosemont students earned the distinction of being AP Scholars through the College board; 11 of those students graduated, and 14 are current seniors.
