



Our Student Support Center Team will be conducting Signs of Suicide Assemblies during the month of February every Tuesday during 2nd period beginning with  $9^{th}$  grade on February  $7^{th}$ .

\*This presentation is  $\frac{required}{req}$  as part of AB 2246, to provide pupil suicide prevention curriculum to grades 7-12.
