The CDC's COVID Community Level for Sacramento County lowered to the medium level last week and has remained there. This means that indoor masking as of tomorrow, January 9th will not be required, **but strongly encouraged**. Please see additional information here. Attendance

As we return for the new year, it's critical to refocus on our goal for every student to maintain 95% attendance for the school year. **We are currently at 89%, well below our goal, and our chronic absentee rate is 35.5%.** Students who are absent two or more days of school per month are considered chronically absent. They miss in-person instruction as well as

opportunities to be positively engaged on campus. Please do everything you can to ensure that students attend every day unless they are ill or experience some other unavoidable emergency. We would also encourage that families limit early dismissals whenever possible.

Here are some hints for supporting improved attendance:

- Make sure your students keep a regular bedtime and establish a morning routine, so they are rested and alert when they get to school.
- Turn off all electronics including TVs, phones and tablets at bedtime.
- Make sure clothes and pack backpacks are ready the night before.
- Check with our school nurse or office staff if you are not sure about when to keep your student at home due to illness.
- Avoid scheduling vacations or doctors; appointments when school is in session.
- Talk to teachers and counselors for advice if your student feels anxious about going to school.
- Develop back up plans for getting to school if something comes up. Call on a family member, neighbor, or another parent to take your student to school.

We are here to help if students are experiencing hardships that negatively impact their ability to attend. Please contact counselors, teachers, or administrators if you need support!
