

Hello, Wolverine Senior Families -

Remember to check the <u>Information for 2023 Seniors</u>, which includes important information about the Rosemont 2023 Graduation Ceremony. Here is some additional information about Sutter Health Park:

- *Tickets per Graduate:* Each graduate will receive **10 tickets.** No exceptions.
- *Caps:* Seniors **may** decorate their caps for the ceremony. For decorations, seniors **must adhere to all school rules**. No profanity, no depictions of illegal activities, no offensive words or images, etc. Students who have anything inappropriate on their cap will be provided with a loaner cap to cross the stage.
- *Mobile Ticketing:* Tickets will be distributed electronically to each graduate prior to the ceremony. The graduate will then have the opportunity to transfer the mobile tickets to his/her family members who will be in attendance. Upon entry, family members will pull up their mobile device to scan. THERE ARE NO PAPER TICKETS.
- *Cashless facility:* Sutter Health Park and the parking lots within the park DO NOT ACCEPT CASH. Credit/Debit card and other forms of electronic payment only will be accepted.
- *Food and Beverage Options:* Concourse concessions will be open for food and beverage purchase. Card payment only.
- *Clear Bag Policy:* Sutter Health Park enforces a clear bag policy and asks guests to open their bags for inspection. Guests may bring in non-clear bags if no larger than 5" x 8" (about the size of a half sheet of paper). If guests come with a larger bag that is not clear, they will be asked to store it in our lockers for a nominal fee or take it back to their vehicle. All guests will pass through the metal detector upon entry, as well.
- *Balloons/Signs/Noisemakers:* None of these items are allowed in the park.
- *Parking:* Parking is \$10 per vehicle for all Sutter Health Park operated lots. Upon entry, you must pay via credit card or debit card. Parking lots will be open at 4:00 pm, which is one hour before gates open to the public.
- *What if I Need Help Accessing or Transferring my Tickets?* Take a look at the step-by-step ticketing guide on <u>this page</u> and/or watch the ticket management video. If you have tried everything and are still having issues, the Ticket Office will be open the day of the graduation ceremony at 4:30 pm.

- Meeting Graduates After the Ceremony: Graduates will be exiting through the same gate that
  they entered at the corner of Riverfront Street and Ballpark Drive. To reunite with your graduate, you
  can find them along Ballpark Drive or designate a place in the parking lot to meet.
   \* Consider that graduates will pick up their diplomas before they exit the park.
- **Do Babies Need a Ticket to Enter?** Children 2 years and older will need a ticket to enter the ballpark. Children under 2 years old may enter the ballpark without a ticket and will need to sit on an adult's lap through the duration of the ceremony.
- *Graduates' Entrance:* Graduates enter through the Right Field Gate at the corner of Riverfront Street and Ballpark Drive. All other guests/family members enter through the main gates. Arrival map here:
