Schedule Update

You may have noticed changes in Infinite Campus to schedules. Draft schedules were handed out to students. Due to program changes and staff transitions coming into this school year, the schedule is still being adjusted. There will be some roster and schedule adjustments up to August 30th. First Day Procedures

First period teachers - Please come to the large conference room (in the front office) early on Thursday morning to pick up a box of 1st day materials. You will receive:

1. Newly-printed schedules for each of your 1st period students
 2. first day packets (forms to go home for signature)
- Pass out first-day packets, and instruct students to **return all forms requiring a signature to their 4th period teacher no later than Tuesday, September 5th.**
 - If a student is in your classroom 1st period but is not on your Infinite Campus roster, he/she **is NOT enrolled in your class.** Send that student to the library (first two days of school). Even if you think a student should be on your roster, he/she is not enrolled in your class if their **name does not appear on the roster.** Infinite Campus rosters are live. If you want to double check to see if a student was just added to your class, log out of IC and log in again.
