# PSAT Day - October 18th

Students in grades 9-11 will be taking PSAT tests from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm on Wednesday, October 18th.

- All students start in their 1st period, then are dismissed to testing rooms.
- Freshmen will be taking the PSAT 8/9
- Sophomores and Juniors will be taking the PSAT/NMSQT (which help qualify your student for scholarships!)
- Seniors will be doing Senior activities
- Please note that your student will have their phones OFF and in their backpacks from 8:30 am 12:45pm.
- If you need to get ahold of your student you can call the front desk at 916-395-5130
- Be sure to get a good night of rest.
- Bring your laptop and a positive mindset!
- Test Schedule and more details will be sent out by Tuesday.

# **End of School Day Update**

- Front office hours are 8:00 AM 4:00 PM M-W, and F, and 8:00 AM 3:00 PM on Thursdays.
- Before and after school, access to the front office is through the front doors facing the parking lot.
- Students may exit through the front gate until 4:00 PM, and the mid-gate (in front of the gym) and the back lot until 5:00 PM. After that, all students must exit through the east end toward the student parking lot.
- Please do not bang on windows in the office to have someone let you through.
- Athletes checking bags must do so one at a time. Please have your friends wait outside. If students continue to disregard the direction of staff in the office, we will close the athletic storage.

#### **New Early Dismissal Policy**

Effective immediately, early dismissals for a Doctor or Dental appointment will be recorded as "OTHER" (unexcused) until we receive a Doctor/Dental note to confirm the appointment. Please provide the note within 2 weeks of the absence. Once a medical note is provided, the absence will be changed to "HLTH" (excused). We also want to remind you of other recent attendance policies:

- No early dismissals after 3:00 pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays and 2:00 pm on Thursdays. If you have a scheduled appointment please send a signed note and include a contact phone number with your student the morning of the appointment so the office can issue the early dismissal slip to the student. The student can then show the teacher when it is time to leave. This will expedite the entire procedure and you can be waiting for them.
- We no longer able to give early dismissals over the phone or email. You must come in early and be ready to show ID to the office.

We encourage all parents to track your student's attendance through the Infinite Campus app. If you need an activation key, please call or stop by the office.

### **Alerts and Evacuation Drills and Information**

After our most recent safety meeting the team has been working on updating drill and evacuation procedures. These will roll out this week in preparation for Friday's drill.

Also, there has been some confusion around alerts that have been going off on campus. Door alarms at the stadium that were automatically turned off during school hours last year are now active during the day. We have very recently learned these now need to be turned off manually. This has led to the alarm being tripped and the alert being audible in some parts of the main campus.

You have not been missing drills, nor threats to the safety of staff or students. If there is an alert affecting the main part of campus there will be a clear alarm (think of the fire alarms).

# **Reporting Absences**

#### **Elevator Keys**

Thank you.

## **Early Dismissals**

Early dismissals will end 30 minutes prior to the end of the school day. If you need to pick up a student for an early dismissal please plan to pick them up prior to 3:00 pm on M, T, W, and F and prior to 2:00 pm on Th.

### **First Period Tardies**

PLEASE drop off students in time for them to arrive on time to 1st period. We are already seeing a number of students dropped off very close to the bell (at 8:23) or after the bell has rung. Those students are missing valuable instruction and creating a disruption for 1st period classes. If we can help in any way with this process, let us know!

### **Tardies Throughout the Day**

In order for teachers to maximize instruction, **students must arrive to every class on time**. They have seven minutes for passing, which includes time for them to use the restroom and get to their next class. This week, we'll start **random tardy sweeps** throughout the day. Students who are not in their classroom when

the bell rings will be assigned after-school detention. Failure to serve detention will result in further disciplinary action.

## **Elevator Keys**

We have a very limited number of elevator keys available for students. If you need an elevator key, please provide a medical note to our office manager. Keys are checked out each morning and returned by the end of each school day.

### **DoorDash and Other Food Delivery Services**

Just a reminder that we do not allow DoorDash or other food deliveries for students. If students receive food deliveries, the food will be held until the end of the school day.

Family members can drop off food at the front office. However, unless there is a medical reason on file, students will not be pulled out of class to pick up food.
