- > Seniors and Juniors must have passed all classes required for Graduation and or be currently enrolled in a credit recovery course.

Students who fail to meet any of the above criteria will receive a refund **up to 4/15**. **No refunds for any reason after 4/15**.

### **Update from Rosemont Robotics**

For those of you who will not be able to attend the Board meeting on Thursday, here is what Trustee Christina Pritchett will be sharing when the team is introduced:

"Rosemont Robotics, TEAM 5274, has participated in *FIRST* Robotics since 2014. *FIRST* was established in 1992 and now has over seventy thousand high school aged team members from 30 countries around the world. The founder, Dean Kamen, had an idea to provide a platform for these young people to showcase their unique talents in science, engineering and business in a highly competitive team environment. "*I want to compete for the hearts and minds of kids with the excitement of the Super Bowl.*" These are the words that launched *FIRST*.

TEAM 5274 has been in 152 official matches over the past 10 years, with a record of 70-81-1. In 2016, the team was 14-9-1 and earned a spot at the world championships with a win at the Sacramento Regional. In the past two seasons, the team has had a record of 32-26, finished 2nd twice and 4th twice, and earned a second berth to the Championships.

The team is set to depart for Houston, TX next Wednesday to compete against over 600 teams from 30 countries around the world. To put this event into perspective, there will be 8 full-sized fields in action. Each field will host a standard 75-team tournament, and the winning alliances will advance to the grand finale Saturday night. The grand finale is a moment no one in attendance will forget...

The team will spend its final day in Houston touring the Johnson Space Center. This year's team is most remarkable in several of ways:

- The team has 13 members (3 seniors, 3 juniors, 4 sophomores, & 3 freshman)
- Two of the graduating seniors have been involved with *FIRST* for 6 years, starting with the Albert Einstein Middle School robotics team.
- Two of the juniors, two of the sophomores, and two of the freshmen are also on track to participate for 6 years.
- There are 6 rookies.
- There are 4 girls and 9 boys.
- This team ended the qualification matches in the top 8 which meant they were automatic alliance captains for the elimination rounds.



## **Inter-and Intra-District Permit Applications Open**

Between April 1 and May 1, families have the opportunity to transfer from another district into SCUSD schools AND SCUSD students may also apply to switch to a different school other than their neighborhood school. The first step is to create a SchoolMint account, add a student and indicate whether your student is currently enrolled in SCUSD schools. Instructions for creating this account and how to apply for an inter- or intra-district permit transfer can be found <a href="here">here</a>. Permits are approved based on space availability at the school of your choice, and grades, attendance, and discipline reports will also be considered.
