The ABC office would like to share the following:


## **Updated Tardy Sweep Information:**

# **Safety Team Support**

Together we have been making an impact in campus culture and we want to keep the momentum going. There are a few reminders to help support us and your colleagues in maintaining.

- Wait until the bell to dismiss students. If a student leaves prior to the bell, please send an email to Mr. Garcia for a referral. Hold to the first 10 and last 10 policy.
- Early release for lunch is 2 minutes. If you go early then in pressures us all.
- Please make sure outreach to parents is documented and referrals are filled out (or entered into IC if you are savvy like that).
- One student at a time on passes and use 5 Star to see the frequency of passes for a student.
- We do use restrictions for groups (i.e., a friend is already out on a pass). Have that volume up or the screen visible on your kiosks to see if a pass is temporarily blocked before the student goes out the door.
