## Comings and Goings

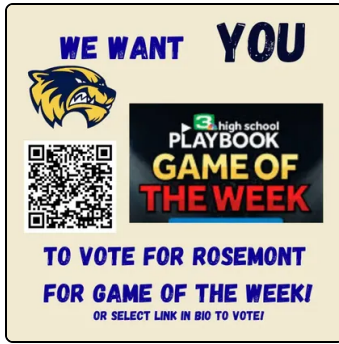

We know there are many more out there and look forward to nominations for October. We are going to select one student per grade each month starting in October.


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# Mock Elections - Juniors and Seniors

Young people have the potential to be a powerful force in elections, but only if they get involved and make voting a habit. To encourage students to become active voters once they are old enough to cast a ballot, Rosemont High School participated in the 2024 California Student Mock Election on October 8, 2024.

Rosemont's Student Mock Election ignited students' interest in voting by tapping into the excitement of the campaign season. As students learned about the candidates and issues in their Government and US History classes, they discovered how government and politics impact every part of their lives. To make the Mock Election as realistic as possible, Sacramento Supervisor Pat Hume facilitated the acquisition of 30 Official Voting Booths for the event. Our students gained firsthand knowledge of how citizens make their voices heard in our democracy and experienced the power of their votes alongside thousands of California students participating in the California Student Mock Election this year.
